DAY 3: Dino Dig

A SCIENCE SIMULATION
Dino Dig Fossil Exploration

Materials: miniature dinosaurs, playdoh, toothpicks, plastic utensils, tweezers, dry paintbrushes, and straws cut at an angle (these work great!)

Directions:

1. Prep a class set of "dinosaur fossils" by enclosing miniature plastic dinosaurs inside playdoh (don't have to be perfectly covered)
2. Each student should receive a fossil and "excavate" the dinosaur using the tools mentioned above. NOTE: they may NOT use their fingers!
3. They should record their findings by drawing pictures before the dig, approximately 3-5 minutes into the dig, and then at the end when the dinosaur is completely excavated.

DAY 3: Extension

WRITING ACTIVITY
What the dinosaurs did at school.

Prep: Take several photographs of plastic dinosaurs doing silly things at school - i.e. snopping a selfie with the principal, reading a book, swinging on the playground, etc!

Directions: After reading the book, *What the Dinosaurs Did Last Night*, explain to students that you found a stack of photographs on your desk this morning. Then, show them the pictures! Give each student a photograph. (I snapped mine with my iPhone and printed them out on the computer - nothing fancy! Even black and white is fine!) Then, they should complete the writing activity to explain what the dinosaurs did at school.

DAY 5: Small Group Research

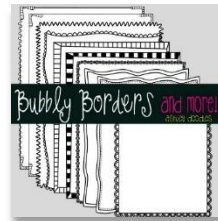
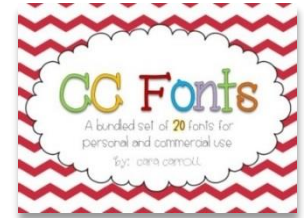
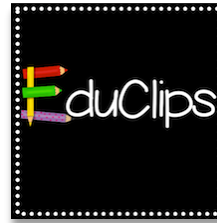
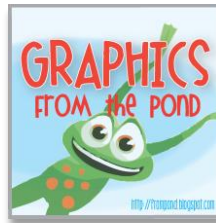
SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH

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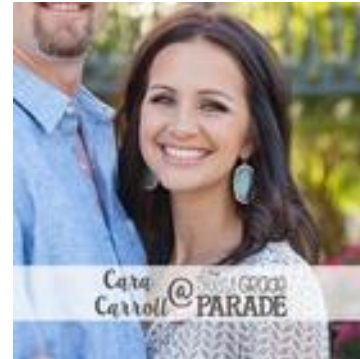
